The Certificate in Couple and Family Therapy Studies

- Recognizes completion of 3 core and 3 elective courses within a 5 year period
- Students are welcome to register and complete any of the new elective courses offered yearly
- Students and OAMFT Members are also welcome to participate in any of the other related therapy courses available through the Office of Open Learning
- Certificate applicants must hold a minimum of a Bachelor's degree in a related field, or a Graduate Masters degree in a related field, and provide official transcripts
- Up to 2 courses may be taken outside of the Certificate Program and may be approved as acceptable credits to graduate
- All courses include 39 contact hours and meet AAMFT requirements
- Classes are typically held over a series of five full days (8 hours per day)
- All courses are taught at the graduate level and students must earn 70% in each course to earn the certificate
- Pre-requisites include completion of two of the three core courses before registering for an elective course
- All courses offered fit one of the five (5) AAMFT categories for educational development: Studies, Therapy, Human Development, Professional Ethics, Research,
- Completion of the OAMFT/University of Guelph Certificate does not imply clinical competence, nor does it ensure acceptance as a Clinical Member of the AAMFT.
- Completion of these Office of Open Learning courses does not imply acceptance or course equivalency in the graduate program in Couple and Family Therapy offered by the Department of Family Relations and Applied Nutrition, University of Guelph.
